## **Important Take-Aways**

At most high schools, graduating class sizes have fluctuated somewhat but remain fairly consistent

On-going collaboration with high schools is critical because:

- more than half of SDA high school graduates (approx. 1,200 each year) do not enroll in <u>any</u> Texas college or university in the "first fall" after graduation
- less than half of all SDA high school graduates who enroll at NTCC are prepared for college level work in all three primary areas: reading, writing, and math
