# **JOB OUTLOOK**

The job outlook for healthcare managers is good, with job growth at 17% from 2014-2024. The annual salary for associate degree healthcare managers ranges between \$30,000 - \$40,000, depending upon location and years of experience (Bureau of Labor Statistics).
